FOOD VENDORS

If you are vending food you will need to comply with State of Michigan Food Safety Laws. When we receive your application we will forward your name to the Western Upper Peninsula Health Department (WUPHD) and they will contact you. Please see http://www.wupdhd.org/environmental-health/food-protection-program/food-service-licensing/ .

ELECTRICAL ACCESS

We **CANNOT** provide electrical access on site. Please make your own arrangements for generators, power cords, cable ramps/rugs for trip prevention, etc. Please notify us if you intend to use a generator as the noise/smell can be disruptive to other vendors. We will do our best to position you so as to not bother other vendors.

WEATHER

This is a rain or shine event, please come prepared! This means tablecloth clips, heavy items to contain napkins/light weight things, etc.

SET UP AND TEAR DOWN

Set up for vendors begins at 10:00am and must be complete by 11:30am. 5th Street will be closed between Wedge Street and Pine Street for the event, with Elm kept open for cross traffic. Vendors have permission to bypass barricades for set up but vehicles MUST be off 5th street by end of set up time at 11:30 am. Please be considerate of other vendors, unpack gear and move your vehicle ASAP.


Access vendor spaces via Portland Street, see second page for map. Vendor spaces will be assigned the second week of August.

PASTY FEST 2023 CRAFT VENDOR SET-UP

Set-up starts at 10am, feel free to bypass barricades to access 5th Street at Portland Street (direction of travel is north, the normal one way traffic). Site #s will be chalked on pavement. Please remove your vehicle immediately upon unloading so that other vendors can have access to the street. Please move vehicles to parking on 4th Street or other side streets until after the street fair is over. Vehicles need to be off street by 11:30am!!! Tear down will not begin until 4pm and vehicle access will not resume until that time.
